1. **WHEN IS GRADUATION?** June 19th, 2017 at 8:00 PM Memorial Stadium
2. **IS THERE A DRESS CODE FOR GRADUATION?** Yes! This is a formal ceremony. You will not be allowed to participate in the ceremony if any changes have been made to the cap and gown. Students are expected to respect themselves, respect their fellow students and respect all the families in attendance by wearing clothing appropriate for the occasion: Dress shoes and long pants for boys: dress shoes without extreme spikes for girls.
3. **DO SENIORS HAVE TO WEAR A CAP AND GOWN?** Yes! This is a formal ceremony and all seniors participating in commencement exercises must wear a cap and gown.
4. **I AM ON THE FINE LIST – WILL I BE ABLE TO PARTICIPATE IN THE GRADUATION CEREMONY?** No! If you have any outstanding fines at Franklin High School, you will not practice for graduation, you will not walk; you will not get your diploma. All fines/fees must be cleared by Friday, May 12, 2017. Please check with the Main office.
5. **IS THERE GRADUATION REHEARSAL?** Yes! Mandatory rehearsals for all seniors will be on June 16 and June 19, 2017.
6. **CAN I BRING BALLOONS TO THE CEREMONY?** Balloons are allowed in the stands with family members but NOT on the field with students.
7. **CAN I CARRY ANYTHING IN MY ARMS DURING THE CEREMONY?** No! (No flowers, stuffed animals, etc.). Your family or friends may hold them for you until after the ceremony.
8. **CAN I TAKE PICTURES OF MY STUDENT AS THEY GET THEIR DIPLOMA?** A photographer will be present on the floor to take a picture of each graduate as students receive their diploma. A copy with order information will be mailed to you shortly after graduation. No other photographers will be allowed on the graduation floor during the ceremony.
9. **ARE OTHER INDIVIDUALS ALLOWED ON THE FLOOR DURING THE CEREMONY?** No other individuals will be allowed on the graduation floor during the ceremony.
10. **DO I HAVE TO HAVE A TICKET TO GET IN?** No. Tickets are not necessary to attend the Graduation Ceremony.
11. **WHERE CAN STUDENTS MEET THEIR FAMILY AND FRIENDS AFTER GRADUATION?** Next to the entrance to Memorial Stadium.
12. **WILL DISRUPTERS BE REMOVED SO I CAN HEAR WHEN MY STUDENT RECEIVES THEIR DIPLOMA?** Anyone who is disruptive on the graduate floor will be warned and if the disruptive behavior continues, they will be removed from the ceremony.
